

Saskatchewan Drama Association New Canadian Drama Program Grant

The Saskatchewan Drama Association provides a grant to encourage New Canadians to participate in Drama Programs across Saskatchewan.

Criteria:

1. The New Canadian participant must have been in Canada less than five years.
2. This grant is available for children, youth and adults.
3. The Community/School Drama Program in which they want to participate must have at least one Adult Drama Member.
4. Applications are taken on a continuous basis throughout the year and are awarded on a 'first come, first served' basis.
5. Grants will be awarded up to \$300.00 per fiscal year per participant.
6. No more than two (2) participants from any one community/school can apply each fiscal year.

The following are examples of allowable expenses. Check with the SDA Provincial Office for other possible allowable expenses:

1. Improv Game Fee
2. Costume for performance
3. Travel to Drama Event, such as SDA Festivals, Theatre Saskatchewan Festivals, School Drama Competitions, etc. Actors, technical support, and audience participants are included.
4. Summer Drama Camp Fee
5. Purchase of Scripts or Drama Resources

The following are not eligible for funding:

1. SDA Festival (Middle Years, Regional, Provincial) Fees
2. SDA Memberships

When possible, the Saskatchewan Drama Association and its funders (Saskatchewan Lotteries, SaskCulture, Inc., Saskatchewan Teachers Federation) must be acknowledged in all promotional material made possible through this grant.

All New Canadian Grant Applications approved by the SDA's Selection Committee will receive funding within 30 days of approval. All approved applicants must submit a written report (form on line) within 90 days of the completion of your event.
