Outstanding Achievement Award

The Saskatchewan Drama Association (SDA) Outstanding Achievement Award is presented on an annual basis. The Board of Directors for SDA recognizes the importance of honoring outstanding achievements and accomplishments of our adult members. They also recognize the importance of preserving the growing history of the Saskatchewan Drama Association. There are many volunteers who have given their time as directors, artists, writers, technical individuals and Board members who have made valuable contributions to the Saskatchewan Drama Association and to the promotion and development of child and youth drama in the province of Saskatchewan.

Criteria for Award:

The award will honor the outstanding achievement of an individual for accumulated dedication or achievement as an adult member of SDA. It may also be presented as a posthumous award.

Eligible recipients will have shown a sustained and significant contribution to the promotion of the growth and development of child and youth drama in Saskatchewan as well as attended and promoted professional development through communication and drama development programs.

The person will have demonstrated respect for all individuals involved in the SDA and a commitment to the ongoing development of child and youth drama in the province.

Nomination for Award:

Nominations may be received from individuals or groups.

The selection of recipients of this award will be reviewed by the Scholarship and Awards Committee of the Saskatchewan Drama Association. There will be a maximum of five awards per year.

How to Nominate a Candidate:

To nominate a candidate for this award, this completed form should be supplemented by letters of reference and/or documentation supporting reasons why the candidate should receive this award. The Scholarship and Awards Committee will use only submitted information to make their selection.

The Scholarship and Awards Committee maintains the right to withhold the award should an eligible nominee not, in their opinion, be forthcoming.

Your nomination and the information contained herein will remain **CONFIDENTIAL** until the official announcement of the recipient(s) is made at the Provincial Festival Awards Ceremony.
