

Saskatchewan Drama Association New Initiative Grant

The Saskatchewan Drama Association provides grants to encourage creativity, accessibility, collaboration and community/school involvement in an initiative that will promote the growth and development of child and youth drama in their community/school. SDA will consider applications whose goals and expectations enable the development, improvement and promotion of the drama experience in their school/community. This initiative grant includes application for a drama workshop for students and adults (actors, technical support, and directors).

Criteria:

1. The applicant must be a SDA Adult Member in good standing.
2. The applicant must submit a written proposal and tentative budget – See the Grant Requirements page for complete details.
3. Applications are taken on a continuous basis throughout the year and are awarded on a ‘first come, first served’ basis.
4. Grants will be awarded up to \$400.00 per year per application.

The following are not eligible for funding:

1. Regional, Middle Years or Provincial Festival Expenses.
2. SDA Membership Fees.
3. Equipment such as Lighting, Sound or anything that would remain the property of the school/community.

The Drama Initiative project must acknowledge the Saskatchewan Drama Association and its funders (SaskCulture, Inc., Saskatchewan Lotteries and the Saskatchewan Teachers Federation) in all promotional material.

All New Initiative Applications approved by the SDA’s Selection Committee will receive funding within 30 days of approval. All approved applicants must submit a written report (form on line) within 90 days of the completion of the initiative.
